#### What is it?

- Chronic inflammatory skin disease in dogs, leading to itching and skin lesions.
- Prevalence: 10-15% of dogs suffers from Atopic Dermatitis!<sup>1</sup>

- · Secondary infections (bacterial or fungal).



#### When to see a vet?




