

CONTEST REGULATION – “Daily lucky draw”

Article 1: Organization of contest

Ceva Santé Animale, a french corporation registered in the Trade and Companies Register of Libourne under the number **301 763 405 00224** and whose head office is located at 8 Rue de Logrono 33500 Libourne, (hereinafter the "Organizing Company"), is organizing a free of charge game during the 2026 European Veterinary Dermatology Congress organized by ESVD-ECVD (hereinafter the “Congress”). This game, titled “Daily lucky draw” (hereinafter the « Game »), will be organized according to the terms described in the present regulation (hereinafter the « Contest »).

The Game will be promoted by the Organizing Company during the event, at the booth.

Article 2: Purpose of the Game

In the context of its participation in the Congress which will take place from 27th to 29th August 2026, the Organizing Company is launching a game open to any individual participating in the Congress, which objective is to answer 1 question per day.

On the Organizing Company’s booth, the participants will be invited to give their answer on a dedicated webpage [ESVD 2026 – Lille – Documentation Ceva](#)

Article 3: Participation requirements and Terms of participation

3.1. Participation requirements

The Game is only open to individuals participating in the Congress.

Participation in the Game is strictly personal.

Participation in this Game implies full and complete acceptance of the present Contest.

Failure by participants to comply with these conditions will result in failure of their entry.

Participants understand and agree that the Organizing Company is entitled to request any supporting documentation it deems necessary, as regards the identity and address of participants.

Any false indication of identity will automatically result in elimination from the Game.

3.2. Terms of participation

The participants can participate in the Game by filling the form available on the dedicated webpage [ESVD 2026 – Lille – Documentation Ceva](#). Three forms will be open, one per congress day, from Thursday the 27th of August until Saturday the 29th of the same.

The participants can play multiple times, each day.

Article 4: Notification of winner

The winners will be contacted by email by the Organizing Company not later than 16 October.

Article 5: Prizes

Each day, the 3 winners will be drawn at random from among the participants who will find the right answer to the questions. The draw will be realized by the Organizing company on the website www.tirage-au-sort.net . The first draw determines the winner of the prize 1 and so on.

Each day the prizes consist of:

- For the winner 1: 1 kit of 2 DOUXO S3 towel size 30x50cm & 50x100cm (value = 35€), 1 set of DOUXO S3 pins for Crocs (value = 5€), 1 DOUXO S3 lick mat (value = 5€), 1 DOUXO S3 ceramic mug (value = 5€), 1 DOUXO S3 mouse pad (value = 3€)
- For the winner 2: 1 DOUXO S3 towel size 30x50cm (value = 15€), 1 set of DOUXO S3 pins for Crocs (value = 5€), 1 DOUXO S3 lick mat (value = 5€), 1 DOUXO S3 mouse pad (value = 3€)
- For the winner 3: 1 set of DOUXO S3 pins for Crocs (value = 5€), 1 DOUXO S3 mouse pad (value = 3€), 1 DOUXO S3 lick mat (value = 5€).

The value of the prizes is simply mentioned as indicative information and cannot give rise to any claim. All expenses incurred after the game shall be borne entirely by the winner.

The Organizing Company reserves the right to replace the prize won with a prize of the same value and/or with similar characteristics, without this giving rise to any claim. Any photographs representing "the Prize" are exclusively for illustrative purposes and are not contractual.

The prizes are not exchangeable and may not under any circumstances be the object of payment of its value in cash. It is specified that the Organizing Company will not provide any service or guarantee, the winnings consisting solely of the delivery of the prize provided above. The Organizing Company shall not be held responsible for the use of the prize by the winner.

Article 6: Terms for awarding the prizes

The winner will be informed by the Organizing Company to the email indicated during its registration.

If the email address provided by the Participant is incorrect or does not correspond to that of the winner, or if for any other reason related to technical problems that do not allow the information email to be sent correctly, the Organizing Company shall not be held liable under any circumstances. Similarly, it is not the responsibility of the Organizing Company to search for the contact information of winners who cannot be reached due to an invalid or illegible email address, or an incorrect mailing address.

The prizes will be awarded to the winners during the Congress. Should the presentation of any prize during the Congress prove impossible for operational or other legitimate reasons, the Organizing Company shall ensure that the relevant prize is delivered to the winner within one month following the closing date of the Congress.

The Organizing Company shall determine the method and timing of delivery and will notify the winners of the applicable arrangements.

Article 7: Personal data

The Organizing Company collects the personal data of the Participants in the context of the Game. Only the data provided in the form and, if applicable, the data necessary for the awarding of the prize

will be processed.

The legal basis for the processing is the consent for the Game participation.

The data collected will only be communicated to the following recipients: Employees of Organizing Company who are authorized to access the Data and who strictly need it for the performance of their duties as well as subcontractors of the Organizing Company.

The Organizing Company is authorized by the Participants to communicate their data to subcontractors and/or service providers exclusively for the purposes of managing the Game.

This data will be kept by the Organizing Company for the period necessary for the purpose of processing, i.e. until 3 months after the end of the Game or until the prize-awarding date, should it occur at a later date.

In accordance with the regulations on the protection of personal data, you may, at any time, access your personal data, rectify them, request their deletion, exercise your right to limit or oppose the processing of your personal data and the right to data portability.

Participants who object to the processing of their data, withdraw their consent, or request the erasure of their data before the end of the Challenge shall be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition.

If you feel, after contacting us, that your data protection rights are not being respected, you can submit a complaint to the competent supervisory authority.

The Organizing Company has the right to shorten, extend or cancel this Contest if circumstances, in particular related to the sanitary crisis, require so. Likewise, the dates that are provided herein can also be modified. It shall not be held liable in this regard.

The Participant acknowledges and accepts that the sole obligation of the Organizing Company under the Contest is to register the participants' entries, provided that these entries comply with the terms and conditions of the Contest, and to award the Prizes to the winners, according to the criteria and procedures defined in this Contest.

The Organizing Company shall not be held responsible, without this list being exhaustive, for any technical, hardware or software failure of any kind whatsoever, the risks of contamination by any viruses circulating on the network and the lack of protection of certain data against possible misappropriation.

Participation in the Contest implies knowledge and acceptance of the characteristics and limits of the Internet as regards technical performance, response times for consulting, questioning or transferring information.

The Organizing Company shall not be held liable for any incident or accident that may occur during the use and/or enjoyment of the prize won.

Article 9: Compliance and Dispute Resolution

9.1. Participation in this Contest implies express and unreserved acceptance of this regulation in its entirety. Participation in the Contest implies a loyal attitude, meaning absolute respect for the rules and rights of other participants.

Participants are prohibited from implementing or seeking to implement any participation process that does not strictly comply with the principles of the Contest and this regulation.

The Organizing Company reserves the right to exclude from the Contest any person who does not fully comply with this regulation and to prosecute anyone who attempts to defraud or interfere with the proper conduct of the Contest.

9.2. The Organizing Company may decide to cancel the Contest if it appears that obvious fraud has occurred in any form whatsoever, in particular in a computerized manner in the context of participation in the Contest or the determination of the winners.

The Organizing Company reserves the right to carry out any verification to ensure compliance with this article as well as with the regulation as a whole, in particular to remove any Participant who has committed any abuse or attempted fraud.

It is agreed that the data contained in the Organizing Company's information systems have evidentiary force with respect to the connection elements and information resulting from computer processing relating to the Contest organized by the Organizing Company.

9.3 Any difficulty in applying or interpreting the regulation will be decided exclusively by the Organizing Company. No telephone request or claim concerning the application or interpretation of these rules will be answered.

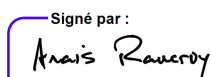
9.4. This regulation is governed by French law.
